

Successful Project Management

6 Step Project Management

1. Idea and Vision

What is the issue we are trying to address?

- ☐ Who are our beneficiaries?
- ☐ What do our beneficiaries have to say about our idea?
- ☐ What will our project achieve in the broadest terms?

2. Objectives and Outcomes

Requirements of the project

- ☐ Map out the story of the project and its users
- ☐ Identify the deliverables required for the project
- ☐ Examine any 'pain points' that might affect your project

3. The Project Plan

What will the project look like

- ☐ Map tasks against timescales
- ☐ Assign workstreams and tasks within team
- ☐ Define budget and funding requirements

4. Funding

Successfully funding the project

- ☐ Identify funding sources
- ☐ Set funding targets and timelines
- ☐ Seek advice from Transformation Cornwall/Diocese if necessary

5. Execution

Rolling out the project

- ☐ Consider a small scale rollout of your service at first
- ☐ Keep communicating with your users and community
- ☐ Repeat this cycle for any alterations to the project

6. Follow-Up

Evaluating your project

- ☐ Is the project delivering on its vision?
- ☐ Are we within budget?
- ☐ How can it be further improved?
